A national effort to honor America's WWII veterans

Of the 16 million Americans who served in World War II, only an estimated 100,000 will be alive in 2021. The youngest: 95 years young. Dream Flights is on a mission to give back to these brave men and women whose sacrifice led to the Sept. 2, 1945 signing of the Japanese Instrument of Surrender, which effectively ended WWII.

The mission is called **Operation September Freedom** (OSF), and beginning Aug. 1, 2021, through Sept. 30, 2021, Dream Flights will honor as many WWII veterans as possible with a Dream Flight using our six restored Boeing Stearman biplanes, the same aircraft used to train aviators during WWII.

Our pilots and crew will stop in towns large and small across the country to meet WWII veterans and their families. We'll hear their stories and fly them in an open cockpit biplane soaring 1,000 feet in the air above family and friends. The experience is pure magic, one Dream Flyers tell us they never forget.

The Dream Flights crews will rendezvous at the 50th National Stearman Fly-In on Sept. 8-9, 2021 in Galesburg, Ill. After honoring WWII veterans at this historic event, our pilots will barnstorm back to their home bases, again stopping in towns to honor as many WWII veterans as possible, completing OSF on Sept. 30, 2021.

Our Dream Flights are free to veterans and funded entirely by sponsorships and donations. Our dedicated pilots, crew members, maintenance personnel and communications staff are all volunteers.








