- ALL ELECTED AND APPOINTED STATE OFFICERS must submit proof of eligibility to the State Adjutantimmediately if you were not a State Officer in 2023-2024. This includes District Commanders, District Senior and Junior Vice Commanders.
- 6. All Posts are hereby directed that they will adhere to the National By-Laws, Manual of Procedures, Ritual and State By-Laws.
- 7. **Post Commanders:** You are directed to Section 218 of the Manual of Procedure, which outlines the duties of various Post Officers. Please ensure that you provide a copy of the duties to these Officers so that they may have a successful year.
- 8. **Post Commanders:** Section 218 of the Manual of Procedure requires that the Post Commander ensures the Post Trustees Report of Audit is properly prepared and submitted each quarter (by deadline) to the State Adjutant.
- 9. District/Post Commanders: Attention is called to the provisions of Section 703 of the National By-Laws: Each Officer accountable for funds or property pursuant to any provision of the By-Laws shall be bonded with an indemnity company as surety in the sum at least equal to the amount of the liquid assets for which, as far as can be anticipated, may be accountable. The Foreign Wars of the United States, Department, District, or Post to which each officer is accountable. The bonds of such accountable officers, in amount and as to surety, shall be approved by their respective units and be held by their respective Commanders. The Commander of each unit shall be responsible for the proper and adequate bonding of all accountable officers in the unit.
- 10. Council of Administration and Committee Chairs: District Commanders are reminded that in the case you are unable to attend the C of A meeting that the Senior or Junior Vice Commander must be present in your place. All C of A and Committee Chairs are advised that you must notify both the Department Commander and Adjutant if you are unable to attend a C of A meeting or Business Session meeting for the 2024-25 year. A copy of your report must be forwarded to the State Adjutant prior to the meeting for minutes inclusion.

- 11. Several Officer Training Schools will be held in the fall of 2024. One will be on Saturday, August 24, 2024 in Florence (Post 3232). Another one will be held on Saturday, September 14, 2024 in Union (Post 4060). Post Commanders, Quartermasters, Adjutants, and Trustees are highly encouraged to attend but all are welcome. Registration is \$30.00 per person, which includes lunch.
- 12. Every Post chartered by the Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States will be expected to participate in the following programs during the 24-25 year: Voice of Democracy, Patriot's Pen, Smart/Maher VFW National Citizen's Education Teacher Award, Buddy Proppy, and National Veteran Service.
- 13. **Commander's Special Project:** The 2024-25 Class of Commanders and Presidents (Team Tribe) will be raising funds for a VFW National Home Tribute Park and endowment fund. On a local level, my goal is to increase training and awareness regarding suicide prevention. The Department will be partnering with several non-profits to provide training and resources. Losing even one comrade to suicide is one too many
- 14. **State Commander Special Visit Request:** Any Post wishing to have the State Commander attend Post of Community functions are to contact the State Adjutant at least four weeks in advance to allow time for the invitation to be scheduled. The Commander will attend as many events as possible.
- 15. All members are reminded that the names, phone numbers, and addresses, including email addresses, shall be considered confidential and shall not be made available for commercial or political use.
